ROUTINE APPOINTMENTS

Appointments are usually scheduled every four weeks with one of our providers (physician or nurse practitioner). We work closely with home health and hospice agencies to arrange for weekly skilled nursing visits and aides as necessary.

Additionally, we recommend physical and occupational therapy for patients with gait instability or weakness after an illness or extended bed rest. Our team works to help our patients function at their highest possible level of health.

In the event of an urgent need, we schedule acute appointments as soon as possible. We work with hospitalists for any inpatient hospital stay of our patients - Texas Health Resources, Baylor Scott & White, and Medical City to name a few.
